

Group Leadership Roles

Working as a team...

There are three levels of volunteer leadership in our groups. Each level of leadership takes on a different level of responsibility based on their role. These are the leadership roles and their respective responsibilities...

Mission Team Assistant:

- Committed to work under the authority of their group leader
- Very committed to the group meeting (rarely misses)
- Baptized follower of Jesus Christ / believes the entire Bible is the Word of God

Mission Team Leader:

- Meets the qualifications of a Mission Team Assistant
- Member of Western Hills Church / signed membership covenant (see your group leader if you would like help going through the process of becoming a member)
- Committed to work under the authority of their group coach and the elders/trustees of WHC (attend meetings, read emails, complete assignments, etc.)
- Committed to using the lesson guide and storying method as a reproducible process for group facilitation
- A team player in church-wide ministry (attends weekend service faithfully, giving faithfully, serves and volunteers, helps connect others, etc.)

Mission Team Coach:

- Has led faithfully and successfully as a Mission Team Leader
- Willing to work under the authority of their group pastor to fulfill their responsibilities as a coach
- Successfully worked with their coach to branch a Mission Team (not mandatory before becoming a coach, but a desirable attribute)
