



1. Jesus was a servant leader.
2. Jesus was a forgiving leader.
3. Jesus was a courageous leader.
4. Jesus was a faithful leader.
5. Jesus was a compassionate leader.
6. Jesus was a truthful leader.
7. Jesus was a prayerful leader.

The disciples of Jesus asked Jesus to teach them to pray. He said to them...

Luke 11:1-4

1 Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples."

2 So He said to them, "When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

3 Give us day by day our daily bread.

4 And forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one."

NKJV

Today we are going to unpack the last part of verse

2 ... Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

In order to understand this prayer and its significance we need to understand the worldview of Jesus.

1. Jesus saw the world as having two spiritual kingdoms, the kingdom of God and the kingdom of Satan

Jesus talked freely about these two kingdoms with His disciples and the multitudes. Here is one example.

Luke 11:14-23

14 And He was casting out a demon, and it was mute. So it was, when the demon had gone out, that the mute spoke; and the multitudes marveled.

15 But some of them said, "He casts out demons by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons."

16 Others, testing Him, sought from Him a sign from heaven.

17 But He, knowing their thoughts, said to them: "Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and a house divided against a house falls.

18 If Satan also is divided against himself, how will his kingdom stand? Because you say I cast out demons by Beelzebub.

19 And if I cast out demons by Beelzebub, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore they will be your judges.

20 But if I cast out demons with the finger of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.

21 When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own palace, his goods are in peace.

22 But when a stronger than he comes upon him and overcomes him, he takes from him all his armor in which he trusted, and divides his spoils.

23 He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters.

In the last 24 hours of His life, in His last conversation with His disciples, Jesus called Satan the ruler of this world three times. Jesus referred to Satan 17 times in the gospels. There is another 15 times in the gospel record where Satan is referred to as the devil. There are 56 references to demon or demons in the gospels.

Jesus saw the world as having two spiritual kingdoms, the Kingdom of God and the Kingdom of Satan.

2. Jesus saw every person in the world as either citizens of His kingdom or citizens of Satan's kingdom.

Luke 11:23

23 He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters. NKJV

John 8:42-44

42 Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me.

43 Why do you not understand My speech? Because you are not able to listen to My word.

44 You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.

1 John 5:19

19 We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one. NKJV

Ephesians 2:1-3

1 And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins,

2 in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience,

3 among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.

3. Jesus saw Himself as the only one that could save people from the Kingdom of Satan.

John 12:31-32

31 Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out.

32 And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself."

Luke 4:18-19

18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me,

Because He has anointed Me

To preach the gospel to the poor;

He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,

To proclaim liberty to the captives

And recovery of sight to the blind,

To set at liberty those who are oppressed;

19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

Acts 10:34-38

34 Then Peter opened his mouth and said: "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality.

35 But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him.

36 The word which God sent to the children of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ — He is Lord of all — 37 that word you know, which was proclaimed throughout all Judea, and began from Galilee after the baptism which John preached:

38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

4. Jesus saw His disciples as His army to help Him save people from Satan's kingdom.

Matthew 16:18-19

18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

19 And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

NKJV

Ephesians 6:12

12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

When Jesus disciples asked Him to teach them to pray, His answer should be interpreted with an understanding of His worldview or His answer to them does not make any sense.

This is especially true of His encouragement to pray....

Luke 11:2 ... Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Some people interpret this prayer to be a concession; a concession of surrender to the will of God; either in your own life or in the life of someone else when you are not sure how to pray for them.

Based on the two-kingdom worldview of Jesus, this was not a prayer of concession but a prayer of confrontation!

Luke 11:2 Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

- This prayer is based on the truth that Jesus has defeated and disarmed Satan and that Jesus is Lord of heaven and earth.
- This prayer is firing a missile at the gates of hell that are holding people in bondage in the kingdom of Satan.
- This prayer is loosening the captives.
- This prayer is using the name of Jesus and the authority of Jesus to exercise the power of Jesus to invade Satan's Kingdom.
- This prayer is invoking His right to rule everything and everyone because He died for the sins of the world.

Praying this prayer is not a prayer of concession it is a prayer of confrontation. It was His strategy for the way His disciples should engage His enemy in spiritual warfare. Praying this prayer is fighting a spiritual battle for the souls of people. It is exercising the power of Jesus by declaring His victory to the principalities, powers, and rulers in the heavenly places.

Besides praying our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, there is not a more important prayer in the bible.

Praying our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name should be seen as putting on the armor of God.

Praying thy Kingdom come, they will be done on earth as it is heaven is taking up your weapon and resisting the devil for the souls of men and women.

Examples of those times the warfare was most visible to me. I have been praying this prayer to storm the gates of hell for about 37 years. I use other prayers to pray for people, but this prayer is my chief weapon of warfare.

When I started praying this prayer, I began to have some unusual spiritual encounters.

Without this worldview and this understanding of the importance of prayer in spiritual warfare...

- There is very little motivation for prayer and a reason to be urgent in prayer.
- Prayer is limited to fox hole prayers.
- There are a whole lot of scriptures about prayer and spiritual warfare that don't make any sense

Jesus was the greatest leader who ever lived because he was prayerful leader. He was a warrior that stormed the gates of hell to save us from Satan's kingdom.

If you are not following Jesus, Jesus said you are against Him. That means you are serving Satan. Jesus said you have been seduced and controlled by Satan.

- He has seduced you into believing there is not a God that loves you.
- He has seduced you into believing that what is right is wrong and what is wrong is right.
- He has seduced you to control you and to get you to do His will.

He has used your weaknesses in your flesh to seduce you do evil things that you wish you had never done.

- He has used the fear of man.
- He has used pride.
- He has used shame.
- He has used bitterness.
- He has used your fleshly desire for personal pleasure.

His aim is to steal, kill, and destroy you and those that you care about.


If you believe this is a reality, there is only one hope for you and your freedom, Jesus!
